2. Conflict/Problem:

Cause of conflict:

Love

Resolution:

They go to the ball, masked so they cannot be detected

3. Conflict/Problem:

Romeo and Juliet's families hate each other

Cause of conflict:

Romeo and Juliet fall in love

Resolution:

They enlist the help of Jeliet's Nurse to send messages

4. Conflict/Problem:

The fight between the family continues

Cause of conflict:

Tybalt looks for Romeo in the streets

Resolution:

The prince banishes Romeo to Mantua for killing Tybalt

5. Conflict/Problem:

Juliet becomes angry at her parents

Cause of conflict:

Their parents arranging a marriage

Resolution:

The parents get angry and tell her to beg if she doesn't marry Paris

6. Conflict/Problem:

Juliet is assumed dead

Cause of conflict:

The arranged marriage

Resolution:

Her body is put in a tomb

7. Conflict/Problem:

Romeo decides to commit suicide

Cause of conflict:

He gets news that Juliet is dead

Resolution:

He kills Paris, then gets poison and drinks it

8. Conflict/Problem:

Juliet joins Romeo in death

Cause of conflict:

She finds out that Romeo is dead

Resolution:

The families make peace
